

Using Berean Builders Science with Veritas

There is no perfect way to synchronize Berean Builders science with a history course, because of the way science progressed. Nevertheless, if you are trying to make your study of science consistent with Veritas, here is how the timeline in Berean Builders science roughly compares to what is found there.

Old Testament, Ancient Egypt

- Parts 1-30: All of *Science in the Beginning*
- Part 31: Lessons 1-16 in *Science in the Ancient World*
- Part 32: Lessons 17-30 in *Science in the Ancient World*

New Testament, Greece, and Rome

(note that the first 21 parts of this year overlap with much of the previous year)

- Parts 1-8: All material that predates *Science in the Ancient World*
- Parts 9-16: Lessons 1-16 in *Science in the Ancient World*
- Parts 17-21: Lessons 17-30 in *Science in the Ancient World*
- Part 22: Lesson 31 in *Science in the Ancient World*
- Parts 23-32: Lessons 32-45 in *Science in the Ancient World*

Medieval Ages, Renaissance, and Reformation

- Parts 1-15: Lessons 46-47 in *Science in the Ancient World*

I would not recommend actually covering science so that it synchronizes with Veritas. Instead, I would recommend that you do one Berean Builders book per year, as follows:

Old Testament, Ancient Egypt	<i>Science in the Beginning</i>
New Testament, Greece, and Rome	<i>Science in the Ancient World</i>
Medieval Ages, Renaissance, and Reformation	<i>Science in the Scientific Revolution</i>
Explorers to 1815	<i>Science in the Age of Reason</i>
1815 to Present	<i>Science in the Industrial Age</i>

If you do it this way, your science will sometimes overlap with your history, but it will often be slightly ahead.
